Good to Greats: Mix and Match

Children's Behavior: Uncovering Clues for Understanding

Participants will explore factors that can affect children's challenging behavior with the goal of uncovering clues and considering the underlying context. Using these clues, participants will create a plan of how to incorporate evidence-based strategies for responding to children's behavior in their classroom.

September 19, 2024 (6:30 -8:30 pm)

Constructing Cultural Sensitivity

Discuss levels of cultural understanding and why increased cultural sensitivity is important to our work. Explore potential barriers and how to overcome them in pursuit of increased personal cultural sensitivity. Introduction to reflective practices that can be helpful when mitigating cultural conflict. Participants will engage in discussions and activities and will leave with increased awareness around and strategies for creating culturally inclusive relationships and environments.

September 24, 2024 (6:30 -8:30 pm)

Introduction to Trauma Informed Care

This training will introduce preschool educators to trauma theory and provide them with knowledge and tools to create a safe and nurturing learning environment for all children. Participants will learn how trauma can impact their classroom, strategies for creating a trauma informed classroom, and mindfulness techniques to support children and adults.

Using a theory of change can help organize and communicate a clear vision for how educators enact data-driven positive change. Through hands-on practice adapted to their unique role, participants will learn how to use a theory of change in their everyday work to achieve desired outcomes.
