Busy Bodies: Active Teaching for Active Kiddos

This workshop uses active, hands-on learning to investigate the processing of our seven senses (yes, seven!) and their role in early learning and development. When fully understood, teachers can assemble a variety of engaging sensory processing activities as a toolbox to reach all learners, especially those that need to move constantly. Explore how to adjust current curriculum and teaching strategies to include more physical activities that stimulate and calm the brain, even when space and time is limited.

Colorado Shines L3-5 Documentation Training

Get some tips, tricks, and techniques you could use to communicate with those you work with more effectively.

Giving and Receiving Feedback: Skill Building Around Hard Conversations for Administrators

Difficult conversations are just that, difficult. This training focuses on supporting directors and coaches in building a culture of feedback in their centers so that these types of conversations can be just a little bit easier. There is an in depth introduction and a significant amount of practice.

Creating a Classroom Culture

Classroom management can be a challenging thing to conquer, especially during the early years of teaching, or when your classroom group is so diverse you can't seem to find any commonalities. What's missing could be a culture within the classroom. Creating a culture within the classroom creates a set of norms, rituals, and language within the individuals involved, including the teachers, children, and families. This session discusses different strategies to implement when building the classroom community, and even further a classroom culture.

Build a Heart-to-Heart Connection with Students

This session will provide practical strategies for creating authentic connections with young learners, emphasizing the importance of empathy, active listening, and personalized support. Ideal for educators seeking to deepen their relationships with students and create a more engaged, emotionally secure learning environment.

EQIT (VIRTUAL - ENGLISH)

This virtual 48-hour training on Saturdays provides teachers, assistant teachers, directors, family child care providers and early interventionists with up-to-date information to enhance their work with infants and toddlers, as well as meet regulatory requirements for training by the State of Colorado. This training is also required for family child care home providers want to change their license type.

The EQ Curriculum is an introductory and comprehensive course in providing quality group care for infants & toddlers. This course builds on the knowledge and experiences of caregivers through interesting, interactive and fun activities. At the heart of the EQ Course is a belief in the importance of providing responsive, respectful, relationship-based quality care for all infants and toddlers.
