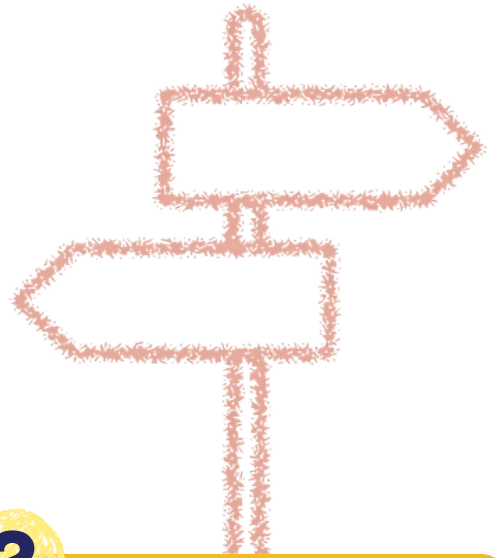


# Hiking + Trail Etiquette Tips

## BE AWARE

Encourage kids to notice signs, trail markers, and changing conditions from the start. This builds awareness so they can stay oriented, recognize risks, and get back safely.

## STAY ON THE TRAIL

Teach kids to stick to designated paths and follow trail rules. Introducing *Leave No Trace* early helps them respect nature by leaving what they find and packing out everything they bring in.

## NO DEVICES

Keep trails quiet by skipping music and loud devices. It helps everyone enjoy nature—and keeps kids more aware of their surroundings.

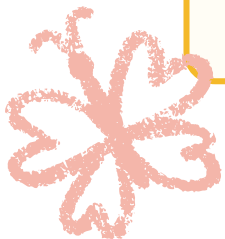
## RIGHT OF WAY

Teach kids to step aside for others—especially uphill hikers or those needing space. Remember: hikers yield to horses, and bikers yield to both hikers and horses.

## RESPECT WILDLIFE

Spotting animals in their natural habitat can be a magical experience for kids. Teach them not to disturb animals out of respect and safety.
